Aerial Photograph	A photo taken from above usually using specialist equipment such as drone.
Human Features	Features of the land that are created by humans,
Physical Features	Features of the land that are not natural and would be present if humans did not exist.
Map	A picture of a place and can be used to help us find where somewhere is located.
Country	An area of land that is controlled by its own government.
Town	A settlement that is larger than a village but smaller than a city. They usually have schools, leisure facilities, , town halls and places of worship.
Route	The directions given to move from one place to another.
