In the upcoming half term, we have lots of exciting learning planned! Our theme is 'Explore and People' and we will be learning about the different continents and oceans in the world as well the physical and human features found in the UK and our local area.

In Maths, the children will focus on measurement of lengths, reading and interpreting data from graphs and tell the time using minute and hour hand. Science lessons will involve looking at the growth of animals including humans as well as how to maintain a healthy and balanced diet and good hygiene. For Art, the children will be getting creative by completing expressive painting. In Computing, they will develop their skills in using algorithms to programme a robot. In RE, we'll explore the theme of generosity, reflecting on why it is important and how it impacts our lives. Finally, in PE, the children will explore making different shapes and balances with their bodies in gymnastics.
