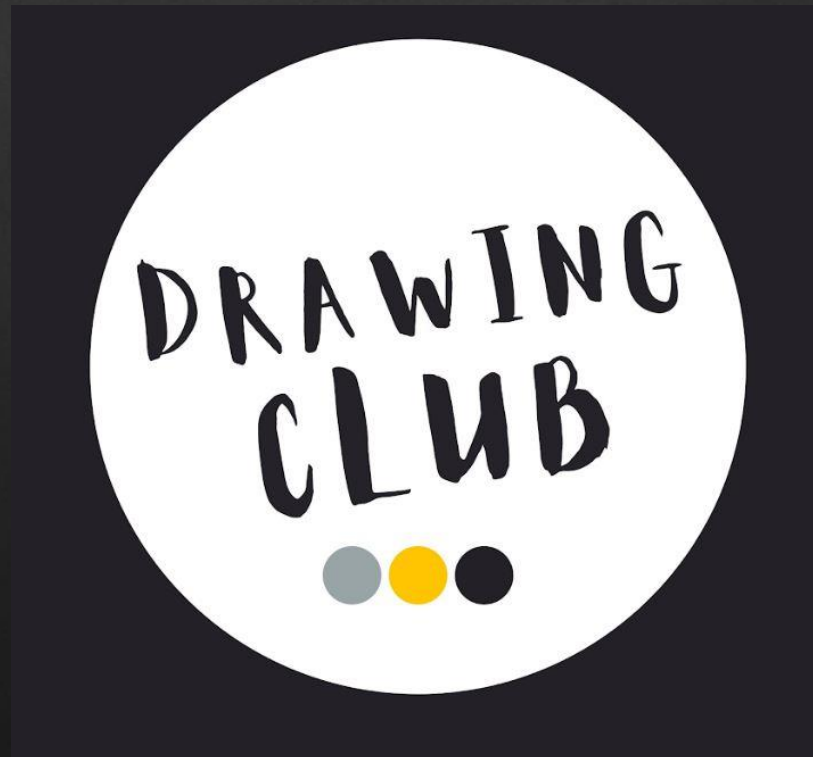

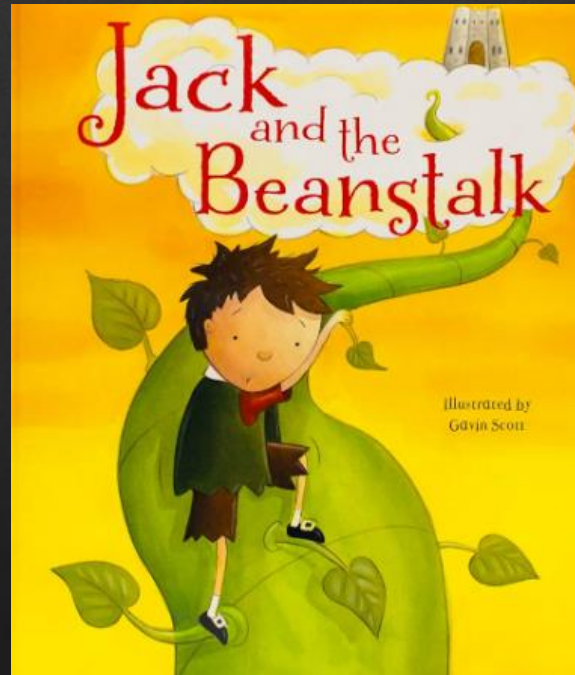
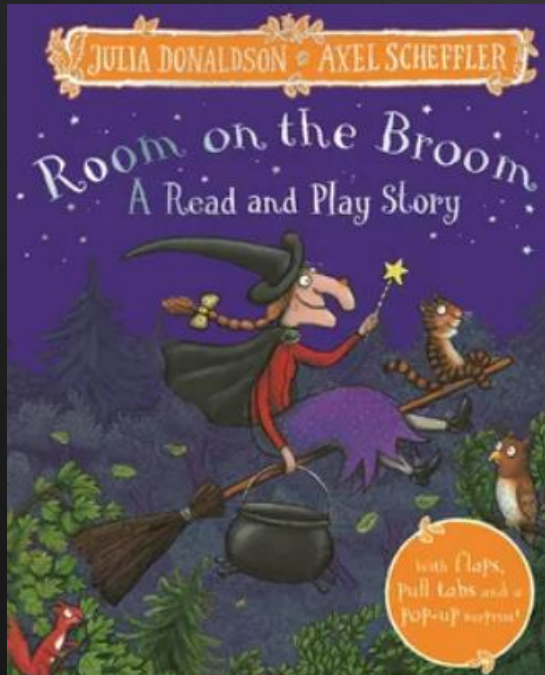


What is Drawing Club?

- We come up with 6 -8 words.

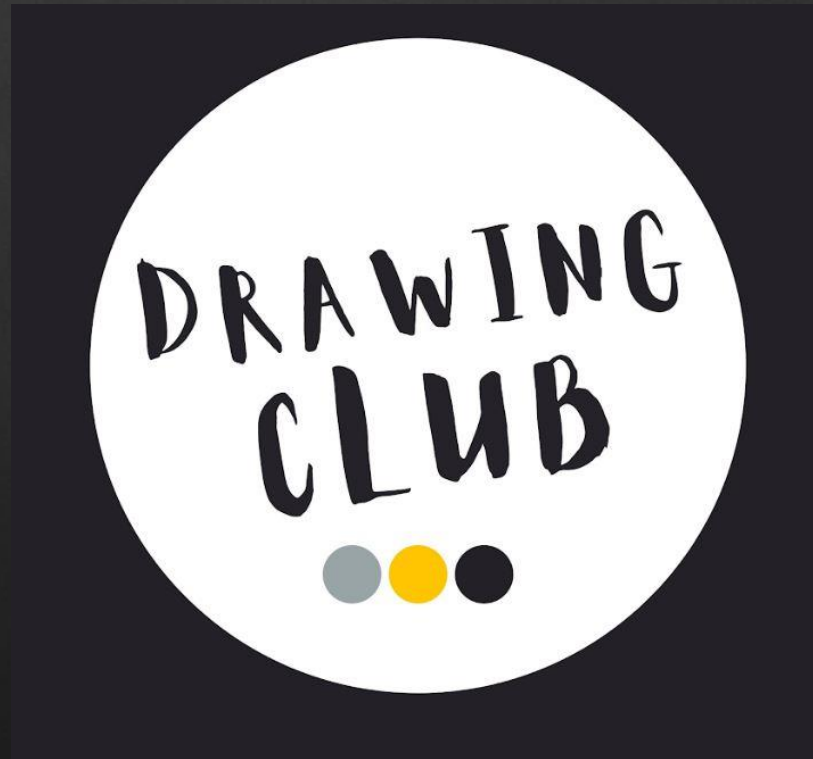
Drawing Club sessions
