



# CREW FAQ



*Here are a few of the questions our parents often ask when they join the Crew. If there is anything else you need to know or need us to know please do not hesitate to get in touch.*

## What are the session times and where do we go?



**Full Day Care:** 7:30am - 5:30pm

**Morning Session:** 7:30am - 12:30pm

**Afternoon Session:** 12:30pm - 5:30pm

**School Day:** 8:45am - 3:30pm

Unless you are attending a **School Day** session please come in through the main school entrance. If you are coming for a **School Day** session the Nursery side gate will be open between 8:45am - 9:00am and then again at 3:15pm - 3:30pm.

## What does my child need to wear?

**PLEASE PUT YOUR CHILD'S NAME IN ANY ITEM OF CLOTHING OR FOOTWEAR THAT COMES INTO LITTLE PIRATES TO ENSURE THEY CAN BE RETURNED TO YOU IF THEY ARE LOST FOR ANY REASON.**



Please wear appropriate sensible shoes that fit well. It is best if your child can put these on themselves to promote independence. Open toed shoes, sling back shoes, high heels, soft slipper type shoes and crocs are **not** appropriate.

As we play inside and out all year round it is essential that your child has appropriate clothing for the weather each day. Wellington boots in rainy weather, sunhat and sun cream on hot sunny days (i.e. May to September).



The best clothing allows your child to cope with it themselves, for example elasticated waist/pull up trousers are better than a more complicated belt they may need help with. A change of clothes to be kept on their peg is essential for the everyday splashes and accidents in the Crew.



## What will my child eat at nursery?

Breakfast is available between 7:30am and 8:20am each day.

Healthy snacks of fruit with a drink of milk or water is available in both the morning and afternoon sessions. (We insist that each child at least has something to drink in each session)

Lunch is at 11:50 am and Tea is at 4:00pm. Details of these menus are kept up to date on the school website.

## What Do Parents need to do now?



- Talk to your child about starting in Crew.
  - Talk to staff and keep them up to date with all your child's needs.
  - Make sure your details are kept up to date including emergency contacts and designated adults that have permission to collect your child. We will only release your child to a person over the age of 16 and designated by you.
  - Keep in touch. Ask any questions. Come into Crew and find out what your child has been up to and share their learning story from time to time. We also have a scheme

for borrowing learning stories please talk to your child's key person or room leader to find out more.
