

Our Creative Habit - Disciplined



This half term we will be supporting our pupils to reflect independently on their work.

We can use sentence stems such as:

I need to practice..

I want to improve..

I think it could be better if..

I've spotted....I will.

We have been sharing and modelling that it is okay to make 'marvellous mistakes' and that we can learn more by making mistakes. The children have been developing their use of this vocabulary and we will continue to support them to identify these within their work and then reflect on how they can improve.

The children have made a fantastic start to their spring term.

We have had lots of fun-filled activities that have taken place, this includes participation in Jump in Projects, Science festivals, Numeracy Day, Parent cafes and many more.
