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Aims

Our uniform policy promotes a sense of belonging, equality and pride in our school. It is designed to be:

- Affordable and accessible, with minimal branded items.
- Practical and comfortable for active learning.
- Inclusive, ensuring adaptations for SEND, cultural or religious needs.

Clear and consistent, supporting high expectations for presentation

Uniform Expectations

School uniform –

- Black sensible school shoes with plain grey/white socks or grey tights.
- Light grey trousers or shorts.
- Light grey pinafore or skirt.
- Yellow polo shirt (with or without Drake Primary School badge).
- Navy blue jumper or cardigan (with or without Drake Primary School badge).
- Yellow and white checked dress (summer option).

Jewellery -

- Children may wear stud earrings only.
- All earrings must be removed or securely taped for PE, in line with DfE safety guidance and national practice.

No other jewellery (necklaces, bracelets, rings) may be worn

PE Kit

- T-shirt in house colour.
- Navy hoodie.
- Plain black shorts or jogging trousers.
- Plain black plimsolls or trainers.
- Grey/white ankle socks.

Swimming Kit

- Plain navy swimming costume.
- Plain navy swimming trunks (not shorts).

Forest School Kit

- Long-sleeved top (preferably navy, grey or black).
- Trousers (no skirts or shorts).
- Waterproof coat/jacket, trousers and wellies.

All clothing should be clearly labelled with your child's name.

Branded & Unbranded Uniform

- PE hoodies and team hoodies can be purchased from **Ipswich Trade Centre** - [Drake Primary School, School Uniform - Ipswich Trade Centre - Ipswich, England](#)
- Unbranded uniform is widely available from supermarkets and sports retailers.
- We encourage families to use second-hand uniform where possible.

Bags

- Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 should bring a book bag daily.
- Children in Key Stage 2 (Year 3, 4, 5 & 6) should bring a back pack daily.

Equality, SEND and Religious Considerations

We will always work with families to ensure uniform expectations are appropriate and inclusive. Adaptations may be made for:

- Sensory needs
- Cultural or religious dress requirements
- Medical needs
- Reasonable adjustments for pupils with SEND

This policy will be reviewed annually by the Head of School and Governing Body, ensuring continued alignment with DfE guidance on affordability, equality and safety.
