It is a statutory requirement for children to attend school every day.

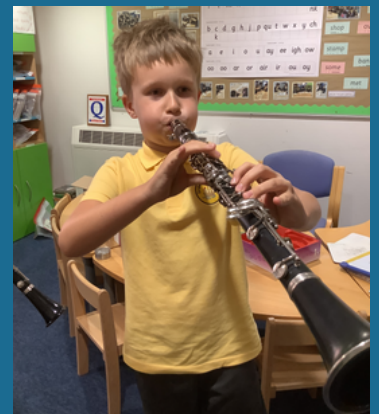
The two classes with the highest attendance this week are Maathai and Hadid!
